

	<i>The EU's biggest ever initiative on alternative testing, SEURAT-1, presented its latest progress report at the World Congress on Alternatives and Animal Use in the Life Sciences. As a key partner in this major research consortium, the JRC has contributed to achievements which include well characterised biological models for in vitro high throughput assays, novel 'omics' and high throughput in vitro based approaches for the identification of toxicity pathways.</i>
<b>26 August</b>	<a href="#">Customs risk management: can transport logistics data improve the analysis of shipping containers?</a>
	<i>The European Commission adopted a new strategy and action plan to improve customs risk management, responding to the need for better knowledge on cargo movements and supply chains. In this effort, the JRC provides scientific and technical support by evaluating the potential benefits of integrating information on shipping container movements and events in pre-arrival customs risk analysis.</i>
<b>25 August</b>	<a href="#">High cereal yields forecast for EU-28</a>
	<i>The latest MARS crop monitoring in Europe bulletin, published on 25<sup>th</sup> of August, reports that overall EU-28 cereal yield forecasts for 2014 remain favourable, at the level of last year and above the average of the past five years (+6.1%). Yield prospects for grain maize are excellent at the moment, with forecast yields 11% above the level of last year and the past five years' average.</i>
<b>19 August</b>	<a href="#">New thematic report: Science for Nuclear safety and security</a>
	<i>The JRC has released a new report giving a comprehensive overview of its research on nuclear safety and security, including their policy background and context. The nuclear activities of the JRC are aimed at supporting the implementation of EU legislation, giving priority to the highest standards for nuclear safety and security in the Union, and internationally.</i>
<b>14 August</b>	<a href="#">The ups and downs of solar energy potential in Europe and Africa in 2030</a>
	<i>A global reduction of aerosols emissions in 2030 will likely result in up to 10% increase of photovoltaic energy (PVE) potential in western Europe and the eastern Mediterranean while a reduction of up to 7% would affect northern Africa and eastern Europe. These are some of the findings published in a recent JRC article which investigates the likely availability of photovoltaic energy (PVE) in Europe and Africa in 2030, under a scenario of reduced anthropogenic emissions, such as greenhouse gases and aerosols</i>
<b>12 August</b>	<a href="#">The potential triple win in smart tax reforms: competitiveness, jobs and the environment</a>
	<i>A new study estimates that EU Member States could make their business sectors more competitive by changing the way taxes are collected from companies. The study suggests that by reducing the business tax burden linked to labour costs (social security contributions, payroll taxes, etc.) and shifting the expected tax revenue to the energy consumption facet instead, Member States could lower companies' overall production costs.</i>

*The JRC published a comprehensive report of breast cancer care services in Europe based on a survey which analysed the current situation in 25 countries that voluntarily participated in the study. This report is a major step towards the development of a European quality assurance scheme for breast cancer services, which is part of the European Commission Initiative on Breast Cancer coordinated by the JRC.*

**5 August**     [Severe forest fire in Sweden](#)

*The largest forest fire in Sweden's recent history raged through the Sala and Surahammar municipalities in Västmanland County, Sweden.*

*Nearby villages have been evacuated, and the fire has been declared a national emergency. The JRC's European Forest Fire Information System (EFFIS) closely monitored the situation. On the request of the Emergency Response Coordination Centre (ERCC), it delivers daily EFFIS reports based on the latest satellite imagery available and meteorological weather forecasts.*

**4 August**     [Healthy eating – healthy ageing?](#)

*Nutritional shortcomings are a key driver of age-related decline and disability whereas proper diet can increase years of healthy life. In support of the European Innovation Partnership on Active and Healthy Ageing (the Partnership), JRC scientists have reviewed the evidence on the role key nutrients and diet plays in promoting healthy ageing.*

*JRC scientists collected evidence on the prevention and treatment of age-related diseases with a focus on under-nutrition in older people, a main cause as well as a consequence of functional decline. The resulting report "The role of Nutrition in Active and Healthy Ageing" provides an important contribution to the overall target of the Partnership which is to increase the average healthy lifespan by two years by 2020, to enable EU citizens to lead healthy, active and independent lives while ageing and to improve the sustainability and efficiency of social and health care.*

*JRC analysis of EU human settlements, land-use and resource efficiency, as well as modelling work addressing options for urban and regional development have fed into the 6th Report on Economic, Social and Territorial Cohesion, released on 23 July by the European Commission.*
